Stained glass is made to be experienced from the inside. And always outlined in black. The popularity and height of sophistication reached his peak in the cathedrals and churches of the Gothic era. Stained glass is a technique that has been known since ancient Egypt. It involved the use of metallic oxides that is fused with the glass at a high temperature. They started the process by drawing a composition on a wood panel the same size as the window opening. Glass blowers produced large sheets and laid them out on the wood template. The painters then added details with enamel emulsion, and the glass was reheated. Finally, the glass was assembled and joined together with lead strips.
