This mask was made in close likeness to the King so that his soul would be able to find him in the afterlife. The Egyptians believe this is very important for the resurrection. The mask is made to protect the head of the mummified body. It is made of gold, lapis, obsidian, and quarts. It is inlaid with semiprecious stones for additional color. And emblems are placed on the forehead of a vulture and a cobra for additional protection.
