

Title: Mask of Agamemnon

Date: 1,580-1,550 BCE

Location: Mycenae Greece

“The golden masks found in tombs reflect they are men, and warriors, and its suggested by the presence of weapons in their graves. The quantities of gold and carefully worked artifacts indicate honor, wealth and status. The custom of clothing leaders in gold leaf is known elsewhere. The Mask of Agamemnon was named by Schliemann after the legendary Greek king of [Homer's Iliad](#). This mask adorned one of the bodies in the shaft graves at Mycenae. Schliemann took this as evidence the Trojan War was a real historical event.”
