Title: Sainte Chappelle

Date: 1243-1248

Location: Paris France

The ratio of glass to stone is higher here than in any other gothic structure, the walls have been reduced to clusters of slender painted colonnetts that frame tall stained glass windows. This style is called a Rayonnant (means radiant) or court style because of its associate with the royal courts of Paris and London. King Louis XV collected biblical relics and the windows tell those stories of how and what relics he “collected”.
